.IT (Italy) opened up for registrations from EFTA countries such as Norway, Iceland, Switzerland and Lichtenstein

May 1st 2012

.PT (Portugal) opened up for registrations from anyone.



Recent changes

December 6th 2011

.FR (France) opened up for registrations from registrations from EU member states and EFTA countries.



.SI (Slovenia) did announce that they will open up for foreign registrars in Fall/winter of 2012.

Quote: "We will start accepting foreign registrar applications soon. At the moment, local presence is required for registrars. In the Fall/Winter of 2012 we will publish all details regarding the requirements and the process of becoming a registrar for .si."
